WHEREAS the Council of Somerville College, in the University of Oxford, has duly made a Special Statute amending the Charter of the College:

SOMERVILLE COLLEGE, OXFORD

SPECIAL STATUTE UNDER ARTICLE 8 OF THE CHARTER.

1. The Body Politic and Corporate named in the Charter as the Principal and Council of Somerville College shall in future be styled the Principal and Fellows of Somerville College, in the University of Oxford (hereinafter referred to as the College).
2. Paragraph (c) of Article 3 of the said Charter is hereby revoked; but nothing in this revocation shall affect the validity or legality of any Act, deed or thing done or executed thereunder. In lieu of this Paragraph there shall be inserted the words "(c) To invest the moneys of the College not immediately required in any of the securities or investments authorised by the Statutes for the time being of the College."
3. In lieu of a Council of the College as provided in Article 4 of the said Charter there shall be a Governing Body of the College as defined by the Statutes for the time being of the College, and all references in the said Charter to the Council of the College shall be construed accordingly. The persons whose names and addresses are set forth in the Schedule hereto shall constitute the first Governing Body.
4. Article 5 of the said Charter and the First Schedule thereto are hereby revoked.
5. In lieu of the Statutes set out in the Second Schedule of the said Charter it is hereby declared that the Statutes of the College shall be those made by the College on the 15th day of June, 1960, under the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923 (and as from time to time hereafter amended under the same Act) and submitted herewith to Her Majesty in Council for approval.

6. Article 6 of the said Charter is hereby amended by deleting the words from "of the Societies of Women Students" to the end of the Article and substituting "of the Colleges to the University, nor until it shall have been approved by Us, Our Heirs or Successors in Council under the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."
