

Alain Locke Studentship 2021-22

This year Hertford College is offering one Alain Locke studentship, which is restricted to Rhodes Scholars whose funding is at an end but who need additional time to complete their studies in Oxford.

The studentship is in memory of <u>Alain Leroy Locke</u>, the first African American, Rhodes Scholar, who entered Hertford in 1907. The Hertford College Alain Locke Studentship will be tenable for a single academic year, and will include free Hertford accommodation*, in addition to the stipend of £5,000 (split into three payments).

Applications should reach the Hertford Academic Office by Monday 5th April 2021. The application form should be accompanied by a one-page curriculum vitae and a list of publications and conference presentations. Two referees should be asked to supply references directly to the Academic Office (please see guidance for referees). Applications and references should be sent by email to academic.office@hertford.ox.ac.uk for the attention of Kim Jones, by the closing date.
