



Legacy Sample Wording

If you would like to remember Somerville in your Will, you may find the following forms of words useful:

As a testamentary clause when drawing up a new Will:

A Pecuniary Bequest

I bequeath to the Principal and Fellows of Somerville College in the University of Oxford (registered charity number 1139440) for their general purposes the sum of £ (..... pounds) free of tax and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer of the Said College for the time being shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors for the said bequest.

Or (b) A Residuary Bequest

I bequeath the whole (or a percentage share) the residue of my estate absolutely to the Principal and Fellows of Somerville College in the University of Oxford (registered charity number 1139440) for their general purposes, and I direct that the receipt of the Treasurer of the Said College for the time being shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors for the said bequest.

If you wish to add a codicil to an existing valid Will:
