



Results of the Internal Comms Survey 2022

Dataset

The survey had 123 responses across the two weeks it was open. The participation breaks down as follows:

- 19 Support Staff
- 29 Academics
- 59 JCR Members
- 16 MCR Members

Of the prize draw incentive, 87 respondents chose to list their names to be eligible.

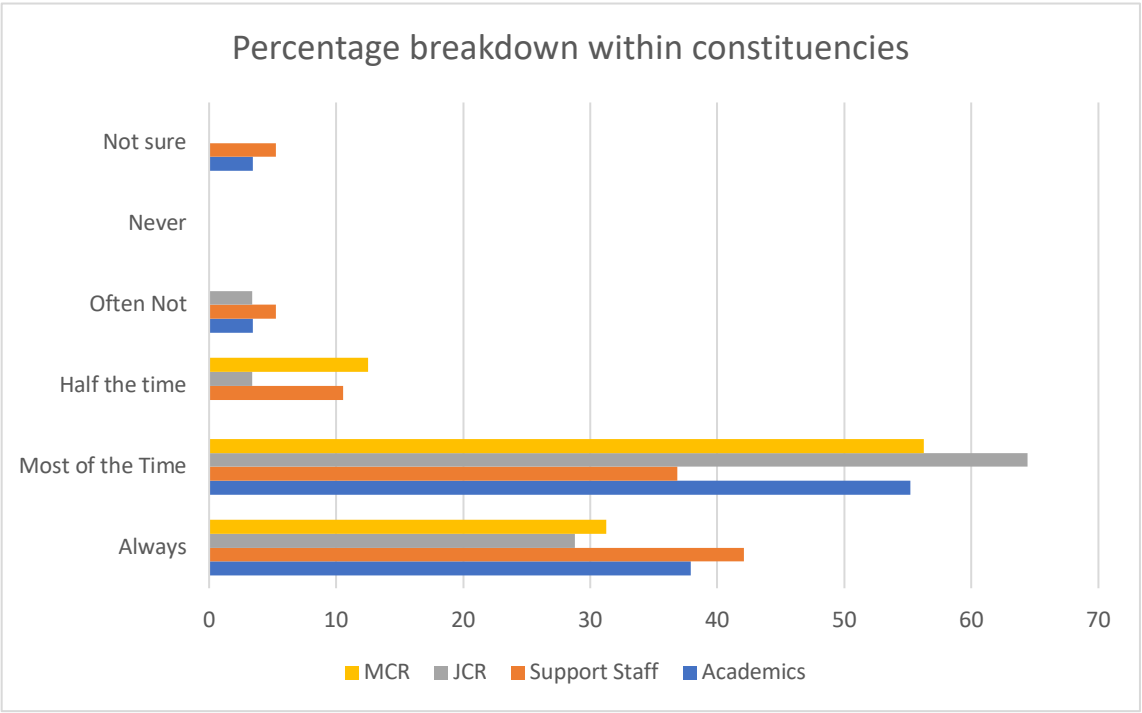
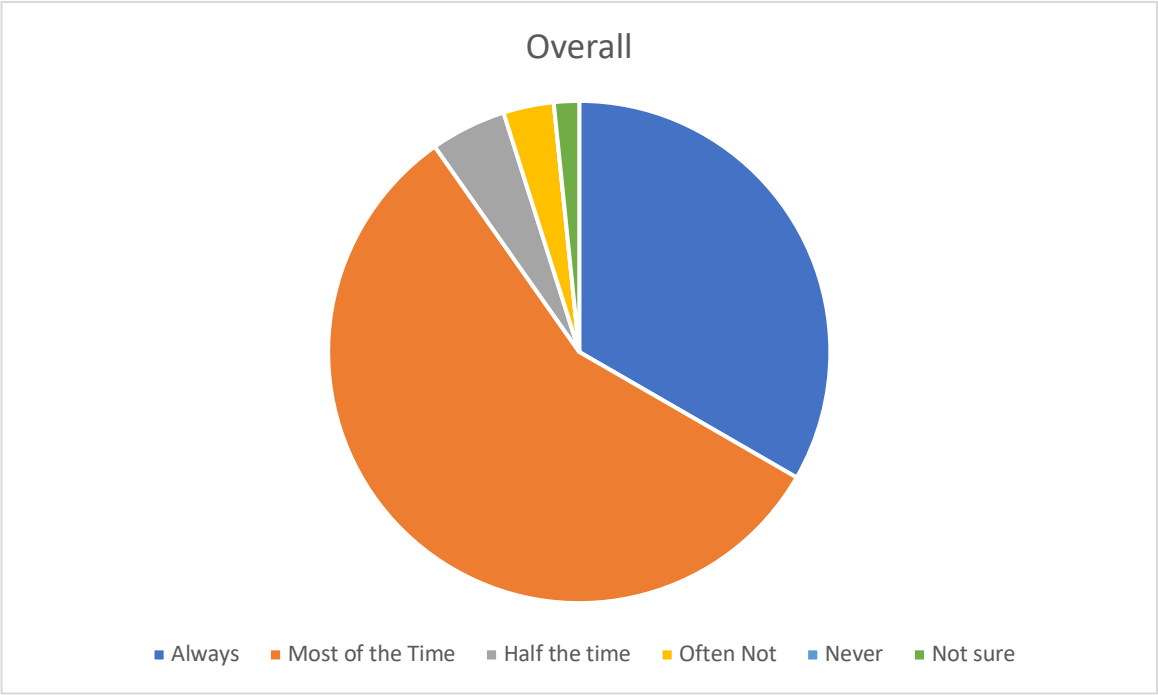

Analysis

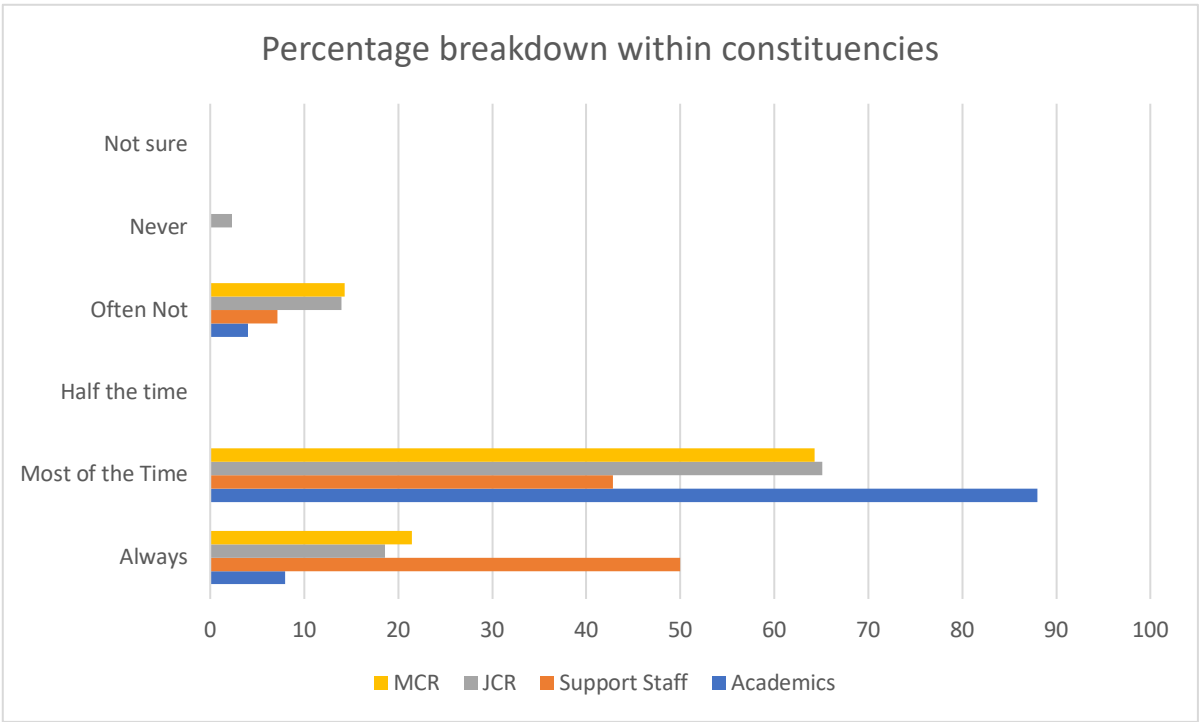
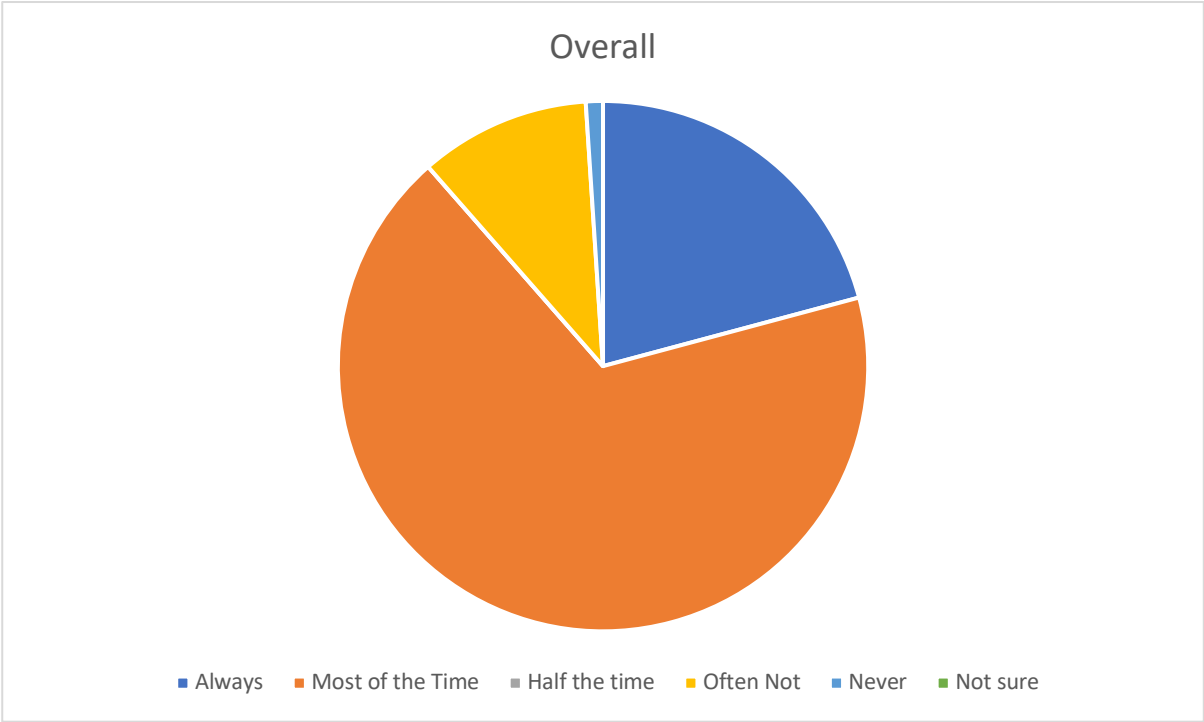
General trends were extrapolated from the quantitative data. Qualitative feedback was taken from the additional comments received (33 responses).

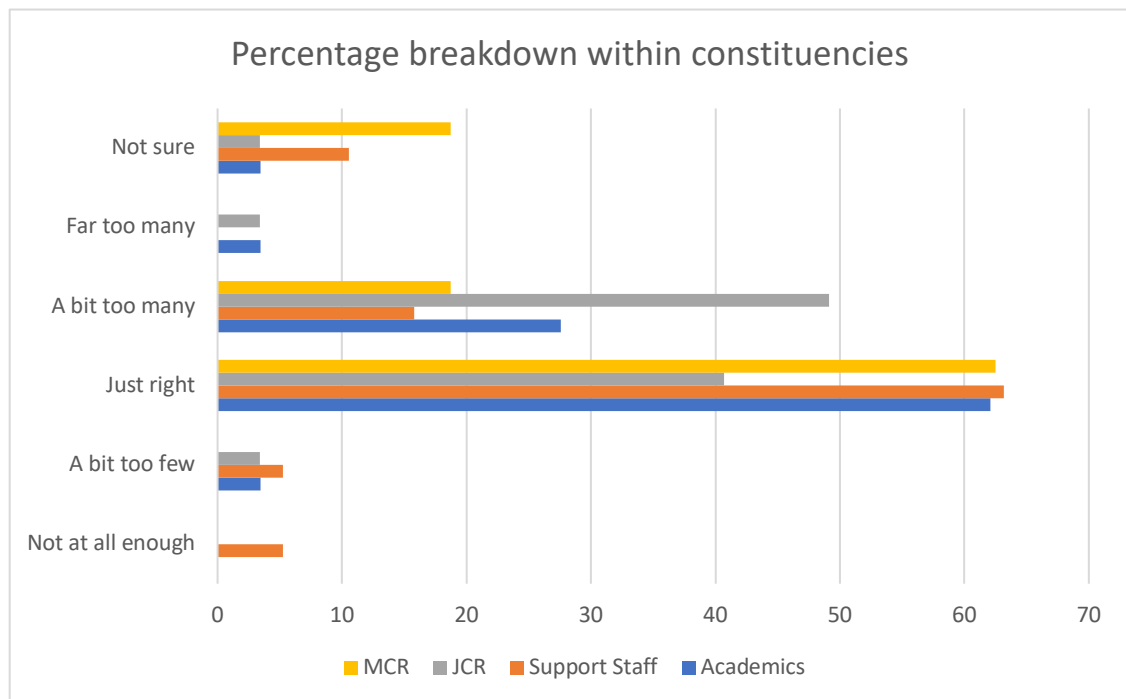
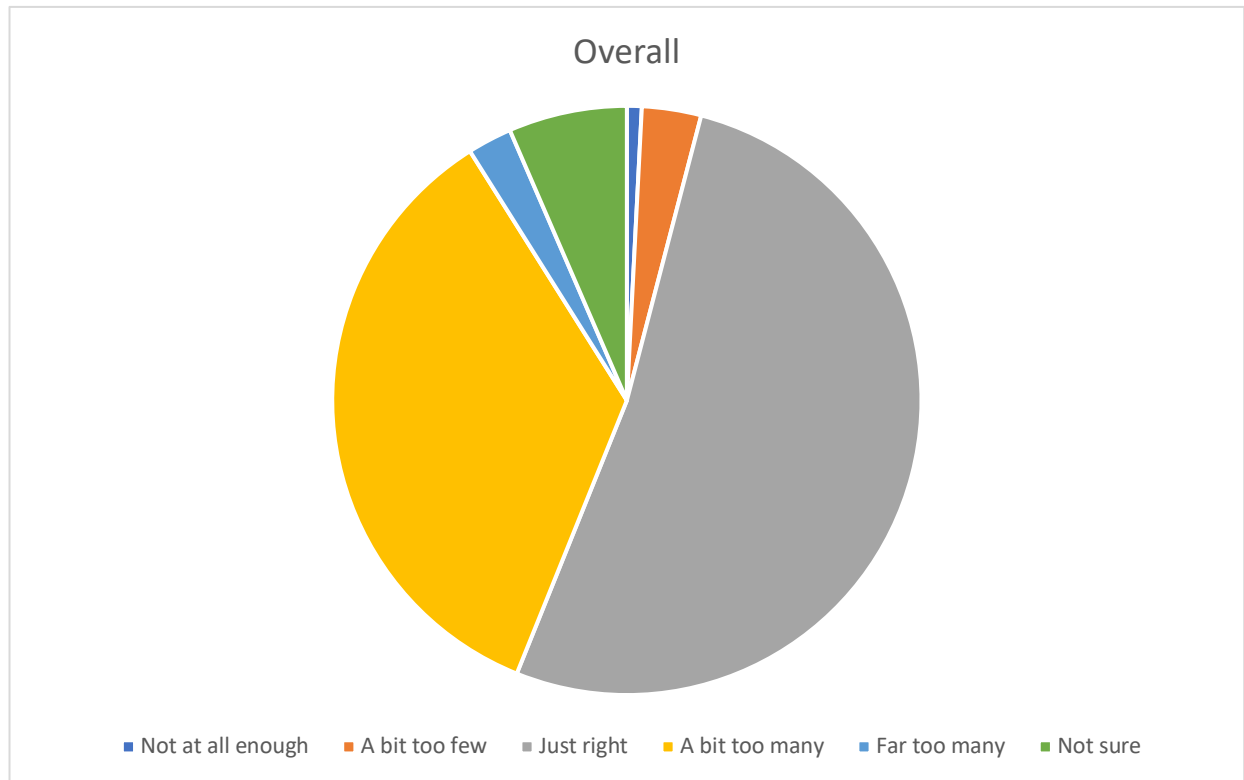
Q.1: Do you feel like you receive key updates effectively?



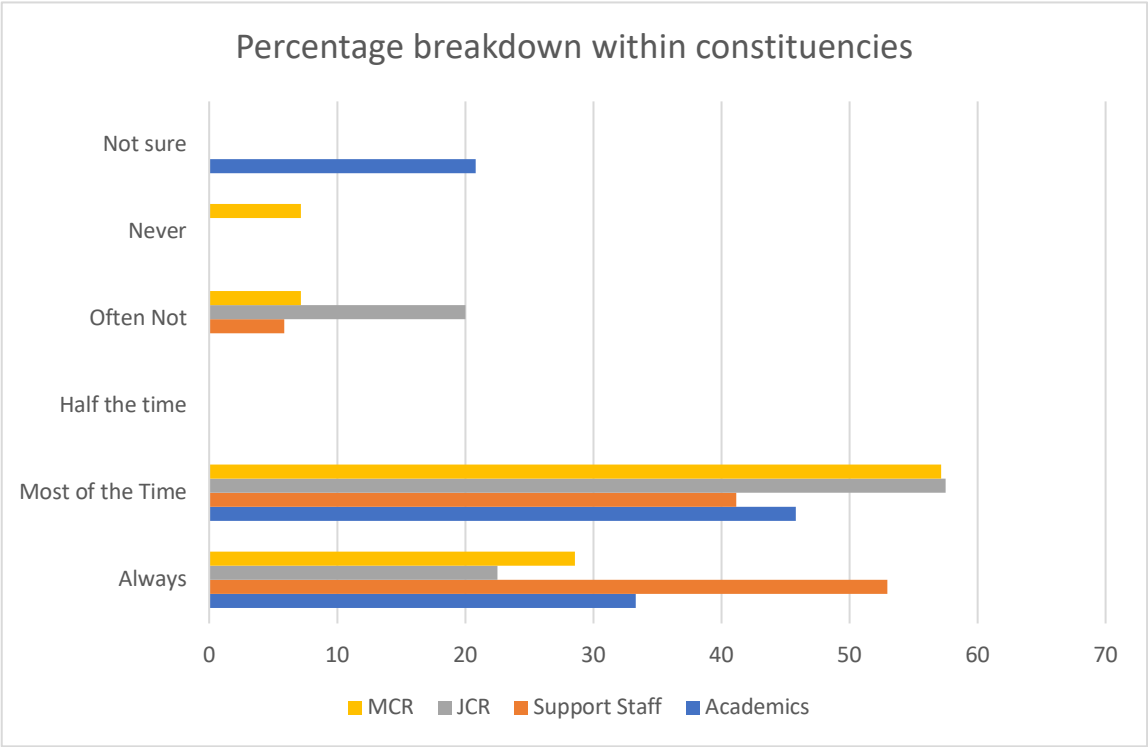
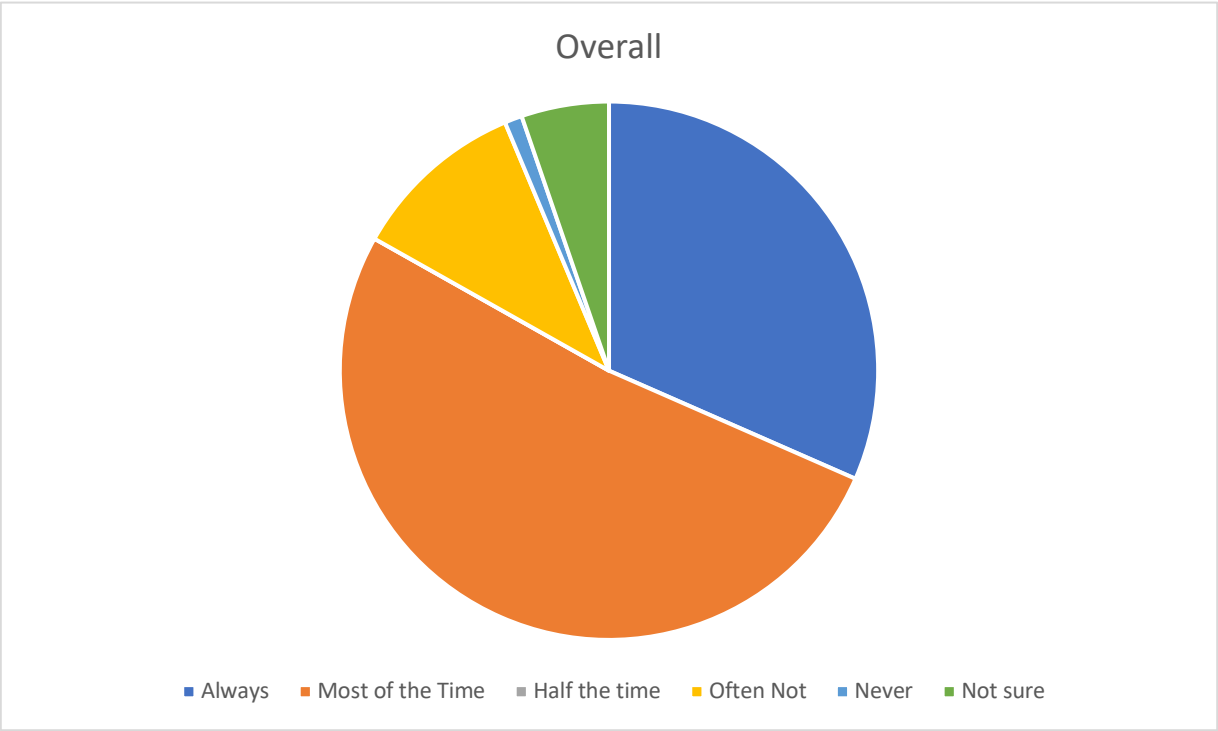
Q2. Do you know how to access key information when you need it?



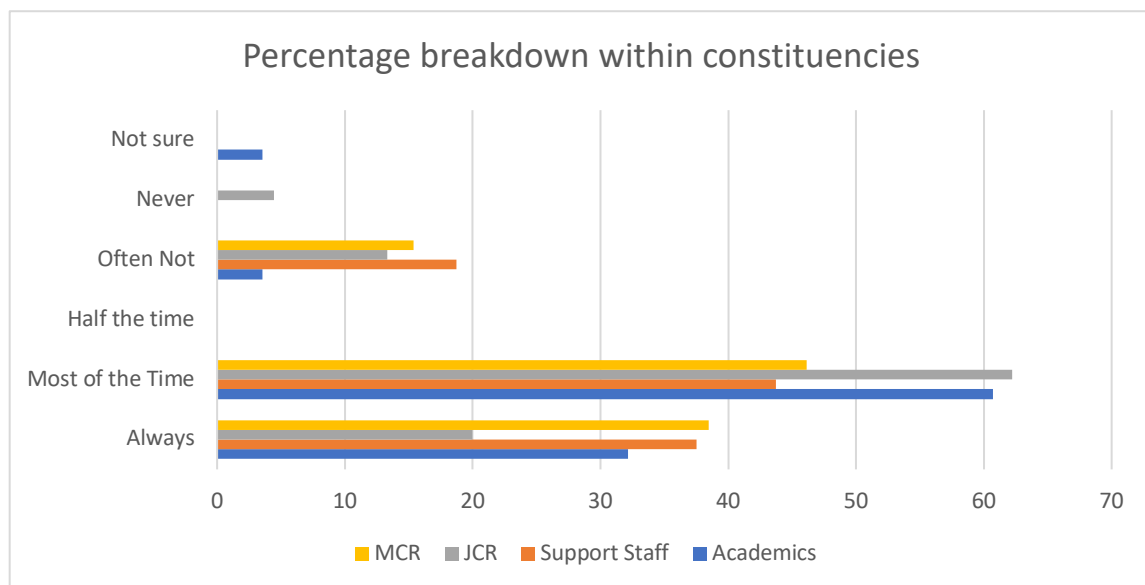
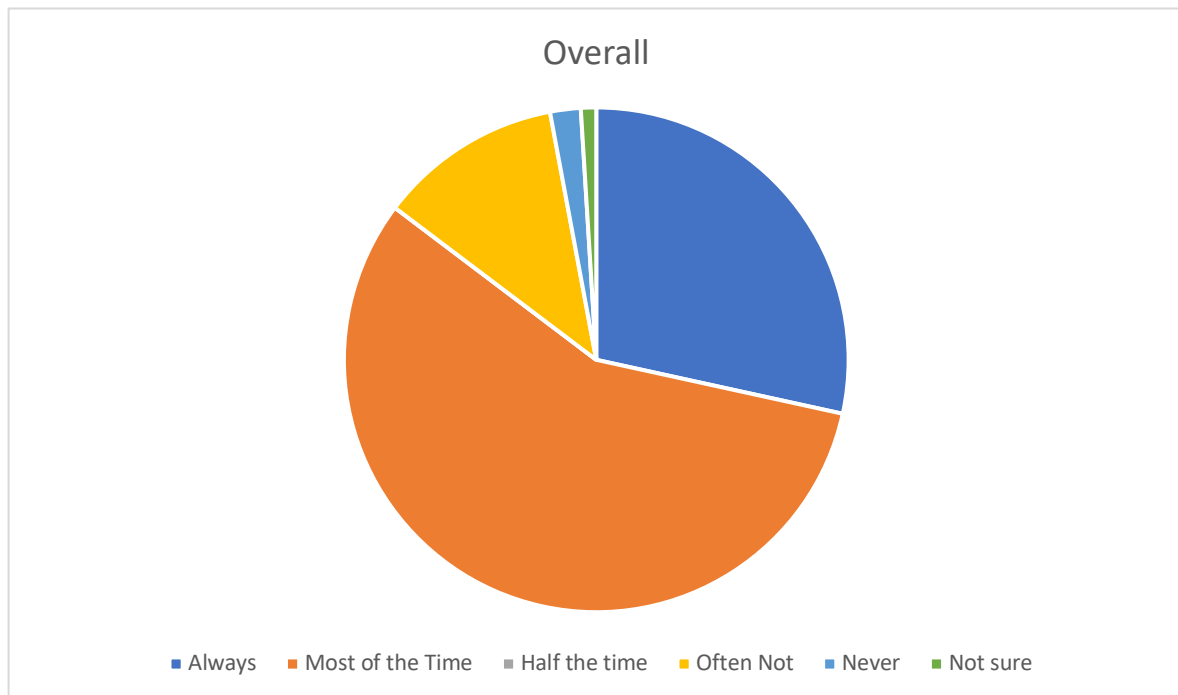
Q3. What do you think about the amount of communications that you receive from college staff?



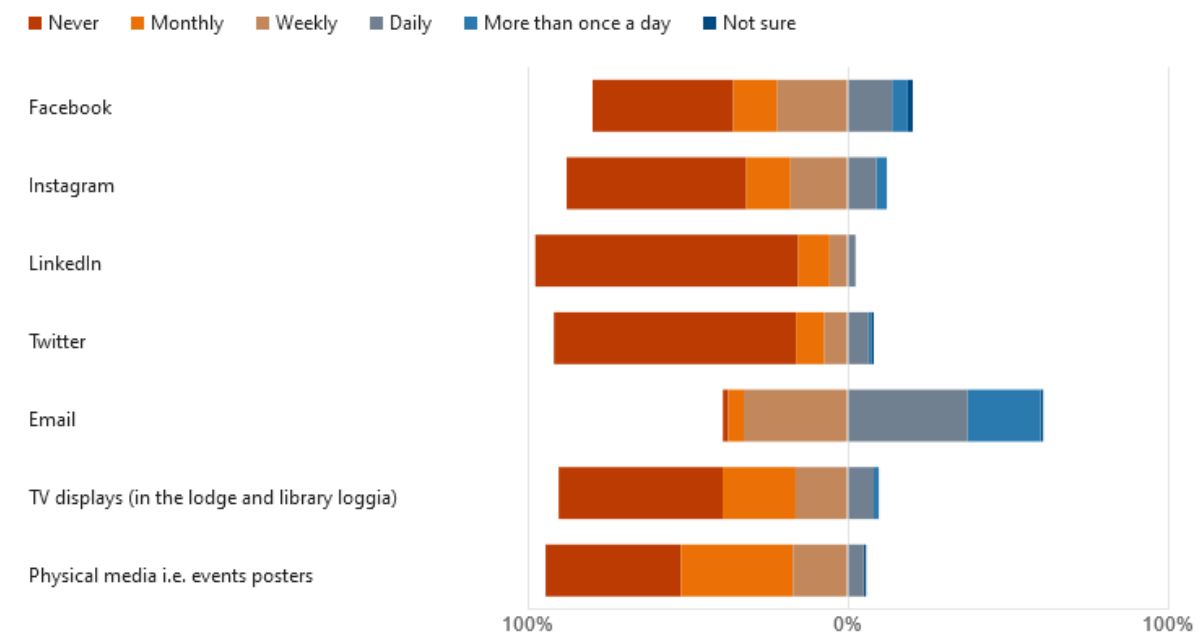
Q4. Do you feel like you know how to access welfare and support when you need it?



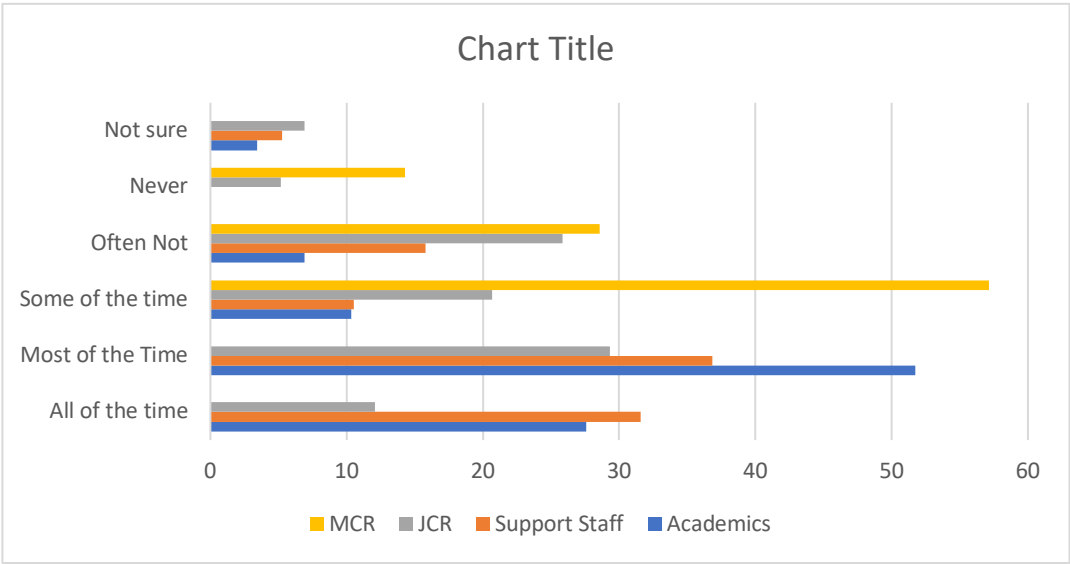
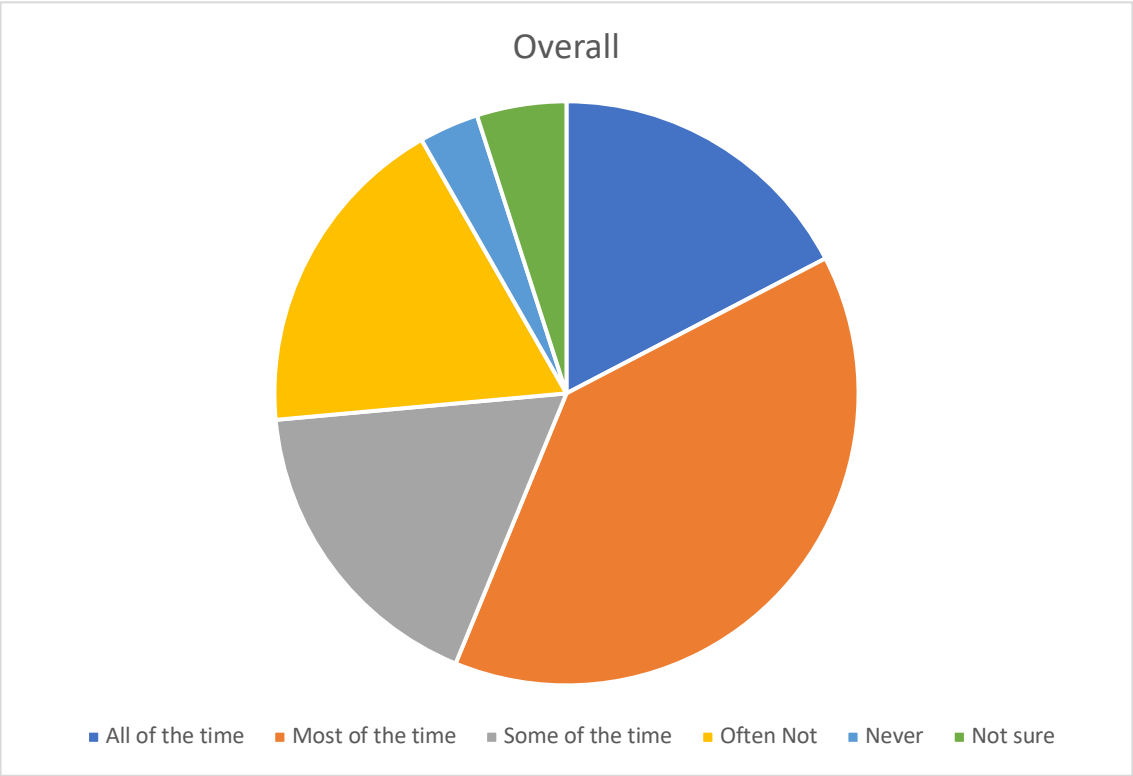
Q5. 'Do you feel like you know about any events and goings on in college that you are able to attend?'



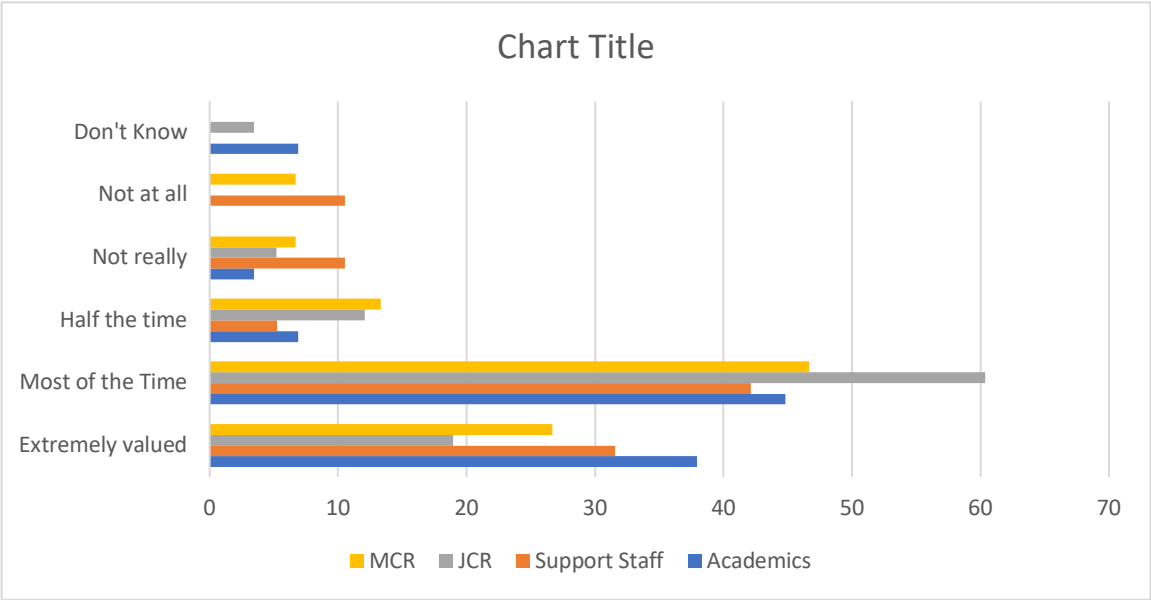
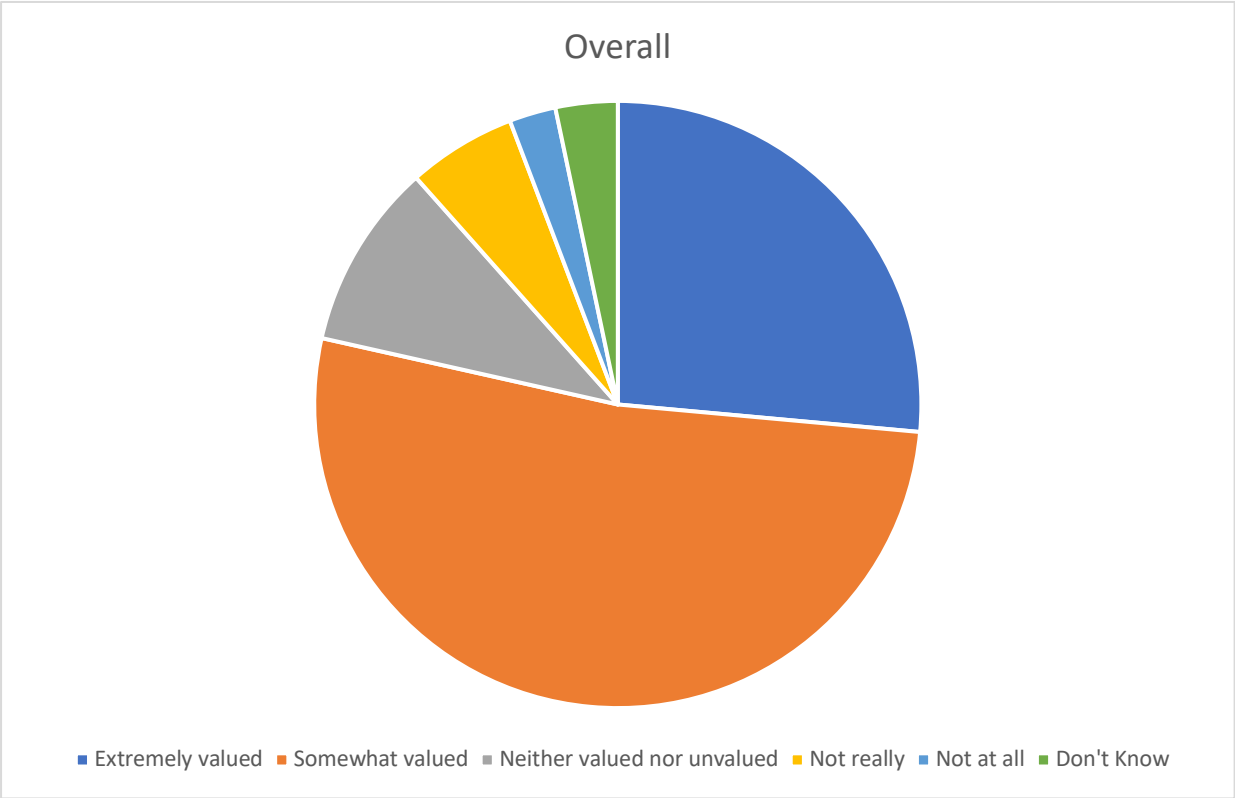
Q6. How often do you engage with us on the following channels:
